

A study examined the effects of ice water [caloric reflex test](#) stimulation on [H reflex](#) amplitude in normal subjects and three [complete spinal cord injury](#) patients. H-reflexes were obtained by stimulating the [tibial nerve](#) at the popliteal fossa and recording the H-response from the [gastrocnemius muscle](#)¹⁾.
