HOXA-AS2 (HOXA Cluster Antisense RNA 2) is an RNA Gene and is affiliated with the lncRNA class. Diseases associated with HOXA-AS2 include Gallbladder Cancer and High-Grade Glioma.

HOXA-AS2 enhanced Glioblastoma cell malignancy through sponging miR-2116-3p and releasing [SERPINA3](#), which might shed light on the diagnosis and therapy for Glioblastoma in the future ^{1) 2)}.
