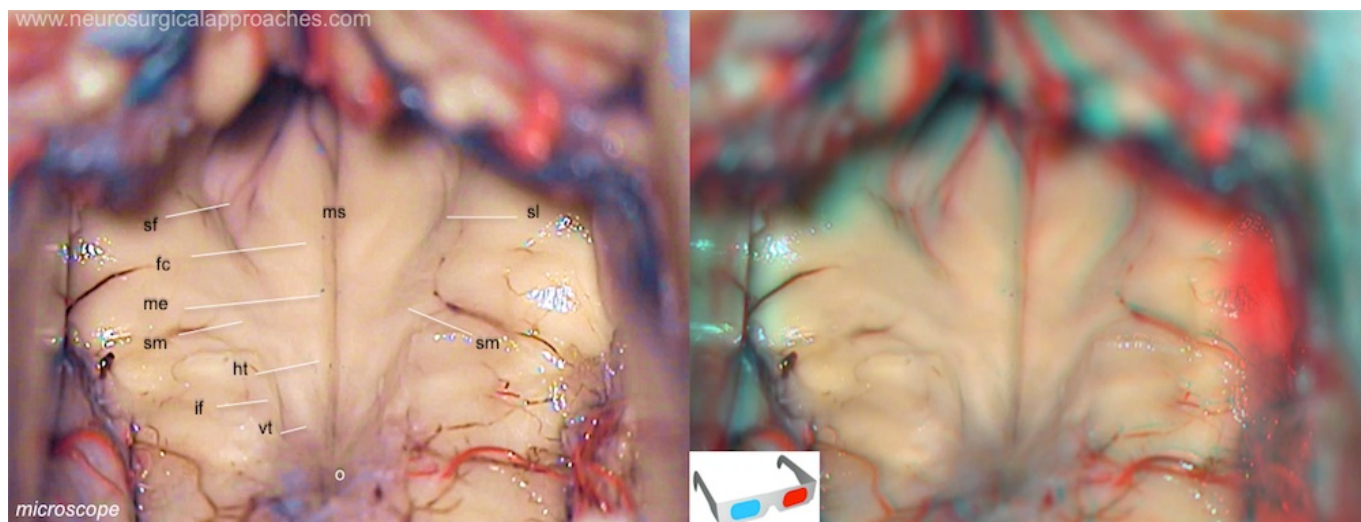


Hypoglossal triangle

Caudally the [hypoglossal nucleus](#) forms the [hypoglossal triangle](#) lying close to the median plane and the dorsal nucleus of the vagus forms the [vagal triangle](#), situated just lateral to the hypoglossal triangle.
