

Idiopathic Normal Pressure Hydrocephalus Classification

It is recommended that INPH be classified into probable, possible, and unlikely categories. It is hoped that these criteria will be widely applied in clinical practice and will promote greater consistency in patient selection in future clinical investigations involving INPH ¹⁾.
