Neurosurgical service in [Indonesia](#) was first established in [1948](#) at Princess Margriet Hospital in [Jakarta](#) (previously known as Batavia) by the Dutch Red Cross during the war for Indonesian independence.

It was the first hospital in Indonesia that was equipped with diagnostic, treatment, and rehabilitation facilities for neurosurgical cases. Initially, the main purpose was to treat Dutch soldiers with central nervous system injuries.

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
