

Burnout is a negative [workplace](#) syndrome of [emotional exhaustion](#), [cynicism](#), and perceived professional [inefficacy](#) that risks the patient-provider relationship, [patient care](#), and physician [well-being](#). Noticeable methodological differences in studies on [trainee](#) and attending burnout contribute to a wide range of neurosurgery burnout estimates and yield significant knowledge gaps. The [environment](#) may have a greater impact on trainee burnout than demographics. [Wellness](#) programs should emphasize solidarity ¹⁾
