

Infiltration

Cancer that has spread beyond the layer of [tissue](#) in which it developed and is growing into surrounding, healthy tissues. Also called invasive cancer.

[Glioblastoma](#) (Glioblastoma), the most aggressive form of brain cancer, is characterized by a high level of [molecular heterogeneity](#), and infiltration by various [immune cell](#) and [stromal cell](#) populations.
