

Infundibulo tuberal syndrome

Infundibulo tuberal [syndrome](#) groups endocrine, metabolic, and behavioral disturbances caused by lesions involving the upper [neurohypophysis](#) (median eminence) and adjacent basal [hypothalamus](#) ([tuber cinereum](#)). It was originally described by Henri Claude and Jean Lhermitte in [1917](#), in a patient with a [craniopharyngioma](#) ¹⁾.
