- **Collaborative Research:** Promoting international research efforts to explore CSF biomarkers, surgical outcomes, and clinical trials.
- **Interdisciplinary Communication:** Facilitating dialogue among neurologists, neuropsychologists, neurosurgeons, and scientists to enhance understanding and treatment of NPH.
