

Intracranial ependymoma clinical features

Intracranial ependymoma clinical features:

Headache

Nausea vomiting

Ataxia or vertigo

Seizures

Incidence of CM: 11–29% of children following surgery for cerebellar tumors³⁵ including medulloblastoma (53%), [posterior fossa ependymoma](#) (33%) & pilocytic astrocytoma (11%).⁴² Risk factors for post-op CM following surgery for medulloblastoma in children: brainstem involvement & midline location.⁴³ Post-op CM has been observed in $\approx$ 1% of adults following p-fossa surgery.⁴⁴

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
