

Intraventricular ependymoma

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58% of [Intraventricular ependymoma](#) originate in the [fourth ventricle](#), while the other 42% are located in the lateral and [third ventricles](#) ¹⁾

Clinical features

The most consistent neurological problem associated with [lateral ventricle tumors](#), including ependymomas, is cognitive impairment associated with hydrocephalus.

If the tumor is present at a critical site for CSF flow, acute obstructive hydrocephalus and sudden death may occur.
