

Intraventricular metastases

Intraventricular [metastases](#) is a very rare finding.

Few [intracranial tumors](#) metastasize to ventricles . Some extra cranial tumors also metastasize to ventricles . Most common site of intraventricular metastases is trigone of lateral ventricles due to high vascular supply of choroid plexus. Next common sites are 4th and 3rd ventricles.

renal cell carcinoma - most common primary

melanoma

breast carcinoma

lung carcinoma- overall most common metastases in the choroid plexus (as it is the most common tumour)
