

Keyhole concept

Traditional large craniotomies have been the standard for aneurysm surgery. However, minimally invasive “keyhole” approaches have gained popularity for aneurysm clipping in recent years.

The keyhole concept in [neurosurgery](#) is designed to minimize the craniotomy needed for the access route to deep intracranial pathologies. Such keyhole surgeries cause less trauma and can be less invasive than conventional surgical techniques.
