

Laminectomy wound infection

Laminectomy wound infection Occurs in 0.9–5% of cases.

May range from superficial to severe dehiscent [wound infection](#) to deeper infection ([discitis/osteomyelitis ± epidural abscess](#)). The risk is increased with [age](#), long term [steroid use](#), [obesity](#), and possibly [DM](#). Intraoperative mild [hypothermia](#) (as commonly occurs in the operating room) may also increase the risk of [wound infection](#) (as demonstrated with colorectal resection). Most are caused by *S. aureus*.

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
