

Lipomyeloschisis

Dorsal [spinal dysraphism](#) with [lipoma](#). Six forms are described, ¹⁾ the following 3 are clinically important as possible causes of progressive neurologic dysfunction via [tethering](#) and/or compression:

1. (intra)dural lipoma
2. [lipomyelomeningocele](#).
3. [fibrolipoma of the filum terminale](#)
