

Liquid embolic agent

The liquid [embolic agents](#) currently used for embolization of [intracranial arteriovenous malformations](#) are [Onyx](#), [NBCA](#), [Glubran 2](#). Used for AVM, these agents can flow through complex vascular structures so the surgeon does not need to target his catheter to every single vessel. Onyx is an example for a liquid embolic agent.

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
