

a “low-flow **graft**” typically refers to a **vascular graft** that is used to **bypass** blood flow in areas with reduced blood supply.

It is possible that such a graft could be used for “**flow augmentation**” in the sense that it could increase blood flow to an area that previously had limited blood supply
