

A [lumbar plexus lesion](#) may cause symptoms in the territories of the iliohypogastric, genitofemoral, ilioinguinal, femoral, and obturator nerves. ... A lumbar plexus lesion often mimic a [femoral neuropathy](#) or an L4 radiculopathy because all present with anterior thigh pain or numbness or quadriceps weakness.
