

Lysine acetylation describes the transfer of an acetyl group from acetyl-coenzyme A (acetyl-CoA) to the primary amine in the  $\epsilon$ -position of the lysine side chain within a protein, a process that leads to neutralization of the position's positive electrostatic charge.
