

In medicine, a mass refers to an abnormal lump or localized swelling of tissue that may be felt or seen on imaging studies. It can represent a wide range of conditions, including cysts, tumors (benign or malignant), abscesses, or other localized growths. The term “mass” is non-specific and usually requires further diagnostic evaluation (e.g., MRI, biopsy) to determine its exact nature and cause.
