

The [microvascular practice](#) of the [future](#) will require [subspecialization](#), [collaborative team effort](#), an [academic medical center](#), regional prominence, and a large catchment population, as well as a [health system](#) that funnels patients from hospital networks outside the region. [Dexterity](#) and meticulous application of microsurgical [technique](#) will remain the fundamental skills of the open vascular neurosurgeon <sup>1)</sup>.
