

Molecular targeted therapy

A type of [treatment](#) that uses [drugs](#) or other substances to target specific [molecules](#) involved in the growth and spread of [cancer](#) cells. Blocking these molecules may kill [cancer cells](#) or may keep cancer cells from growing or spreading. Molecularly targeted therapy may cause less harm to normal cells and may have fewer side effects than other types of cancer treatment.
