## **Types of Multinational Healthcare Entities**

  - Examples: Pfizer, Johnson & Johnson, Siemens Healthineers
- **Multinational NGOs and health systems**: Non-governmental or nonprofit organizations offering health services or aid globally.
  - Examples: Médecins Sans Frontières, International Red Cross
- **Multinational clinical trials**: Research studies conducted across different countries to ensure generalizability of medical treatments in diverse populations.
