

# Multinational (Healthcare)

A 'multinational' in healthcare refers to any organization, company, or initiative that operates in more than one country, typically providing services, conducting research, or distributing products across international borders.

## Types of Multinational Healthcare Entities

- **Multinational healthcare companies:** Corporations that develop, manufacture, or distribute pharmaceuticals, medical devices, or health-related technologies in several countries.

- **Multinational NGOs and health systems:** Non-governmental or nonprofit organizations offering health services or aid globally.
  - *Examples:* [Médecins Sans Frontières](#), [International Red Cross](#)
- **Multinational clinical trials:** Research studies conducted across different countries to ensure generalizability of medical treatments in diverse populations.
