Neoadjuvant chemotherapy refers to the use of chemotherapy to reduce a tumor's size prior to the main treatment course. Neoadjuvant chemotherapy (NACT) is often prescribed when a tumor is presently too large to be operable or in cases when vital organs may be impacted by a tumor's growth
