

Neurilemmomas (neurilemmomas) are benign, encapsulated tumors of the nerve sheath. Their cells of origin are thought to be Schwann cells derived from the neural crest (see the image below); accordingly, they are often referred to as schwannomas.

Minimally symptomatic, and may be surgically enucleated without producing a neurological deficit.
