

# Neurogenic region (NR)

New neurons are continually born throughout adulthood predominantly in several regions of the brain:

The [subventricular zone \(SVZ\)](#)

[Striatal interneurons](#)

The subgranular zone (SGZ), part of the [dentate gyrus](#) of hippocampus.

The [nucleus accumbens](#), specifically medium spiny neurons

[Glioblastoma](#) GBM contrast-enhancing recurrence is significantly associated with proximity to NRs.

NR-contacting initial tumors were more likely to recur out of radiation treatment fields <sup>1)</sup>.
