A critical term referring to the superficial allure of neuroscientific studies that use advanced techniques (e.g., fMRI, tractography, high-gamma recordings) and aesthetic visualizations to impress rather than inform, often lacking in causal rigor, clinical relevance, or conceptual clarity.
