Non-Langerhans cell [histiocytosis](#) refers to a family of histiocytosis characterized by the absence of [Langerhans cells](#). Many manifest cutaneously. the spectrum of non-Langerhans cell histiocytoses includes Benign cephalic histiocytosis. Generalized eruptive histiocytoma.
