

# Non-pulsatile tinnitus

1. occlusion of external ear: cerumen, foreign body
2. middle ear infection (otitis media)
3. otosclerosis
4. stapedial muscle spasms: as occurs in hemifacial spasm
5. CP-angle tumors: including vestibular schwannoma
6. Meniere's disease
7. labyrinthitis
8. endolymphatic sac tumors: e.g. as in von Hippel-Lindau disease
9. drugs
  - a) salicylates: aspirin, bismuth subsalicylate (PeptoBismol®)
  - b) quinine
  - c) aminoglycoside toxicity: streptomycin, tobramycin (tinnitus precedes hearing loss)
