

Carbamazepine and [oxcarbazepine](#) continue to be first choice for [Trigeminal neuralgia medical treatment](#), but have been supplemented by additional options such as [pregabalin](#), [lamotrigine](#), and [Onabotulinum toxin A](#). In patients insufficiently responding to medical treatment, there are neurosurgical treatment options giving very good results. The best long-term results have been described for [microvascular decompression](#), but percutaneous and radiosurgical treatments also are good options, especially in patients with an increased surgical risk profile, in secondary trigeminal neuralgia, and in case of recurrence after microvascular decompression ¹⁾.
