

Patients with [aneurysmal subarachnoid hemorrhage](#) who subsequently developed diarrhea had significantly increased odds of developing [Delayed ischemic neurologic deficit](#). Enteral volume loss due to [osmotic laxative](#) use is a potential risk factor for [Delayed ischemic neurologic deficit](#) after aneurysmal subarachnoid hemorrhage <sup>1)</sup>.
