

The technique of using [percutaneous posterior fixation](#) combined with the anterior or lateral approach is the most accepted option when surgically treating [lumbar spine metastases](#). However, there are limitations to these approaches. For instance, it is extremely difficult to perform minimally invasive lateral corpectomies at L4 and L5.

TTis approach necessitates a long incision and extensive muscular dissection, which are hazards when wound healing is tenuous.

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
