

Pericallosal cistern



Located immediately adjacent to the full length of the [corpus callosum](#); contains portions of [pericallosal artery](#)

Synonym(s): cisterna pericallosa [TA]

Rupture of [pericallosal artery aneurysm](#) in 12 patients gave rise to blood in the pericallosal cistern, anterior interhemispheric fissure and cistern of the lamina terminalis in 11 ¹⁾.
