

Peripheral neuropathy

In conventional medical usage, the word [neuropathy](#) (neuro-, “nervous system” and -pathy, “disease of”) without modifier usually means [peripheral neuropathy](#).

Peripheral [neuropathy](#) (PN) is damage to or disease affecting nerves, which may impair sensation, movement, gland or organ function, or other aspects of health, depending on the type of nerve affected.
