


Petros ridge

Lesions of the petrous ridge are rare. The wide differential diagnosis includes [endolymphatic sac tumor](#), [petrous bone meningioma](#), jugulotympanic paraganglioma, myeloma, and metastasis. The clinician must take into account unique imaging features on CT and MRI, and final diagnosis often requires pathologic analysis ¹⁾
