PICO question

A PICO question is a structured clinical question used in evidence-based medicine to guide literature searches and decision-making. Here's what PICO stands for:

- P Patient, Population, or Problem: Who is the patient or what is the condition?
- I Intervention: What is the main treatment or diagnostic test being considered?
- C Comparison: What is the alternative to compare with the intervention? (optional)
- O Outcome: What are the relevant outcomes (e.g., survival, symptom relief, accuracy)?

Example PICO question: Clinical Question: In adults with glioblastoma, does bevacizumab compared to temozolomide improve overall survival?

PICO breakdown:

- P: Adults with glioblastoma
- I: Bevacizumab
- C: Temozolomide
- O: Overall survival
