


Posterior clinoid process



In the [sphenoid bone](#), the posterior boundary is formed by a square-shaped plate of bone, the [dorsum sellae](#) ending at its superior angles in two tubercles, the posterior clinoid processes, the size and form of which vary considerably in different individuals. The posterior clinoid processes deepen the [sella turcica](#), and give attachment to the [tentorium cerebelli](#).
