


About 5 centimetres (2.0 in) in front of the [occipital lobe](#) of the human brain, on the infero-lateral border is an indentation or notch, named the [preoccipital notch](#). It is considered a landmark because the occipital lobe is located just behind the line that connects that notch with the [parietooccipital sulcus](#).
