

Prophylactic Antibiotic

Definition:

An [antibiotic](#) given before an [infection](#) occurs, to prevent a potential infection rather than to treat an existing one.

Use in context:

Surgeons often administer prophylactic antibiotics before surgery to reduce the risk of [surgical site infections](#).
