

PubMed is a **free resource developed and maintained by the National Center for Biotechnology Information (NCBI)** at the **U.S. National Library of Medicine (NLM)**, part of the **National Institutes of Health (NIH)**. It provides access to **over 35 million citations and abstracts** from biomedical and life sciences **literature**, primarily from the **MEDLINE** database, as well as from **PubMed Central (PMC)** and books.

* **Scope:** Medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, healthcare systems, and preclinical sciences. * **Content types:** Journal articles, case reports, reviews, clinical trials, systematic reviews, and more. * **Indexing quality:** Citations indexed in MEDLINE are curated using the **Medical Subject Headings (MeSH)** vocabulary. * **Access:** PubMed is **freely available to the public**, but full-text access depends on journal or institutional subscriptions, unless the article is open access.
