

Cerebral hyperperfusion syndrome (CHS) is a common complication after **direct bypass surgery** in patients with **Moyamoya disease** (MMD). Since preventive measures may be inadequate, Yang et al. assessed whether the **blood flow** difference between the **superficial temporal artery** (STA) and **recipient vessels** (Δ BF) and the direct perfusion range (DPR) are related to CHS.

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
