Reckless refers to a behavior or decision made with disregard for risks or consequences, often characterized by carelessness, irresponsibility, or a willful ignorance of potential harm.

□ Formal Definition: Reckless (adj.) – Marked by a lack of concern for the danger or consequences of an action; irresponsibly bold or rash.

□ Synonyms: Careless

Rash

Irresponsible

Foolhardy

Thoughtless

Negligent (in legal or clinical contexts)

□ Examples:

Prescribing a high-risk drug without proper monitoring is reckless.

Proceeding with surgery despite unstable vitals may be considered reckless medical conduct.

Using weak data to justify clinical decisions is intellectually reckless.
