

Examples of right-to-left shunting are [congenital cyanotic heart disease](#) and [pulmonary arteriovenous malformations \(PAVMs\)](#) ^{1) 2)}, which form the basis of current recommendations for prophylactic antibiotics in patients with such conditions and for prophylactic closure of PAVMs ³⁾.
