

Sacrococcygeal chordoma

Sacrococcygeal [chordomas](#) are rare and difficult to diagnose tumors.

Because of minimal response to chemotherapy and radiotherapy, resections with wide margins at initial surgery is the most important factor influencing local recurrence ¹⁾.
