Sagittal craniosynostosis is characterized by a pronounced head shape, often referred to as [scaphocephaly](#) or [Dolichocephaly](#)

Scaphocephaly is a term often used interchangeably with [isolated sagittal synostosis](#) because it describes the same condition. Scaphocephaly refers to a specific type of [craniosynostosis](#) where the [sagittal suture](#) closes prematurely, leading to the characteristic long and narrow appearance of the skull.
