

Schwannoma Diagnosis

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Schwannomas usually demonstrated by hypointensity on T1-weighted images and hyperintensity on T2-weighted images.

MRI characteristics ¹⁾ of schwannomas include specific signs (split fat, fascicular, target) and signal patterns (ie isointense T1 signal relative to skeletal muscle; increased and slightly heterogeneous T2 signals).
