A scientific [article](#) is a specific type of [research paper](#) that follows a structured format and is usually published in a peer-reviewed [scientific journal](#).

The top 100 neurosurgical articles in [altmetrics](#) belonged primarily to those with active accounts, with [Journal of Neurosurgery](#) ranking the highest (33%), followed by [Neurosurgery](#) (29%) ¹⁾.

A [journal club](#) is a group of individuals who meet regularly to critically evaluate recent [articles](#) in academic literature, such as scientific [literature](#), medical literature, or philosophy literature. Journal clubs are usually organized around a defined subject in basic or applied [research](#).
