

**isthmic spondylolisthesis AKA spondylolysis:** a failure of the neural arch as a result of a defect in the pars interarticularis (identifiable as a discontinuity in the neck of the “**Scotty dog**” on oblique LS-spine x-ray). May be seen in 5–20% of spine x-rays <sup>1)</sup>. Rarely produces central **spinal canal stenosis** since only the anterior part of the vertebral body shifts forward. May cause narrowing of the **neural foramen**.
