A **scrapbook** is a personalized collection of notes, images, excerpts, and materials gathered and organized for reference, inspiration, or documentation. In academic or clinical settings, a scrapbook can serve as an informal tool for capturing ideas, case snippets, or references that may not yet form part of structured documentation.

□ Key Characteristics

- Informal and user-defined structure
- Can include text, images, clippings, or links
- Used for brainstorming, drafts, or quick captures
- May evolve into formal documents or presentations

□ Uses in Clinical or Academic Settings

- Capturing interesting clinical cases informally
- Saving reference images or diagnostic patterns
- Drafting protocols or documentation ideas
- Organizing teaching material drafts

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
